3. BENEFIT SUPPLEMENTS FROM THE OPERATING FUND IN 2024

The board may decide to grant additional compensation to employed insurees for exceptional dental care costs (e.g. prosthetic care and orthodontic treatment), which may not exceed the normal maximum dental care allowance.

This additional compensation must be applied for from the Sickness Fund.

Specialists' fees and the related administrative fees are fully compensated for to holders of a referral from an occupational health physician. However, ophthalmologists, gynecologists and urologists are excluded from this, as no referral is required for their services and the compensation will cover 100%. Without a referral, compensation is paid out according to Section 14.

Public-sector client fees are fully compensated for according to the maximum amounts specified in the Decree on Client Fees in Social Welfare and Health Care (912/1992):

- outpatient clinic fees
- health center fees
- serial treatment fees
- ambulatory surgery treatment fees
- day ward fees
- hospital-at-home and homecare fees in connection with hospital care; available for up to four months per calendar year
- hospital fees for treating the same illness are compensated for according to the lowest payment category for up to 180 days.

4. COMPENSATION CAP FOR PROCEDURAL FEES IN 2024

Compensation cap for a private hospital's service fee (procedural fee): 80% but not exceeding €1,500.00.

Sports events are excluded: If an injury has occurred during sports at a club/in a team/on a level where a license/insurance is mandatory or recommended, the board may decide to reduce the compensation to half of the full amount. In that case, the compensation will be 40%, but no more than €750.00.
